

RULE 105 – QUANTITY

Section 1. UNIT OF WEIGHT

Emu oil shall be sold on a net weight basis in pounds (kilograms). Unit weight is 7.6 lbs. (3.447 kg)/gallons (e.785 liters).

Section 2. UNIT OF SALE

The unit of sale may, by mutual agreement between Buyer and Seller at time of sale be by the drum, barrel, or 5 gallon pails. If sale is made in containers the approximate weight of the containers in net pounds shall be specified.

The following container net weights in pounds will be considered as standard weights unless Buyer and Seller mutually agree on some other agree at the time of sale.

Steel Drum	418 lbs. (189.6 kg)
5 gallon pail	38 lbs. (17.24 kg)

Section 5. TOLERANCE

The tolerance shall be one standard deviation above net weight.
