Committee Reports:

Oil - Committee working hard. One company is not in compliance with the Certified Oil Program and is not responding to previous letters. A lawyer has been contacted and will send a formal letter

Phone - Not many calls over the holidays. One looking for eggs. Another about a loose emu. With increasing use of technology we will probably be seeing fewer and fewer phone calls.

<u>Newsletter</u> – Current editor is having difficulties getting newsletters together. New editor will take over and will try to get all three newsletters out before the end of February.

USDA Processing Plant Training Video - Member is exploring options.

<u>Convention BOD Meeting</u> - Wednesday has been added to the board meetings for the 2020 convention (Arrive Tuesday night w/ board meetings Wednesday and Thursday mornings thru Sunday at 1 pm). Brian agreed to stay until Monday to pay the convention bill, if needed. New contract with modifications has been signed. BOD discussed those needing to leave early on Sunday. Agreed that no one would be penalized because of early flights.

<u>2020</u> Convention- Sept. 11-13, Huntsville, AL - There is an animal science program at the Huntsville, Alabama University.

Ideas: * We could offer a student discount to attend the emu convention. Also, list a one day only price to attend sessions on either Friday or Saturday from 9 am to 5 pm.

• Alabama University was asked if they would like a booth at the 2020 AEA Convention. Will contact agriculture department heads.

 \cdot Jay attended Ostrich Association Convention. He liked that they had only a few speakers, more farm information, more breakout sessions and round table discussions. We need info on this convention, i.e., price for meals, topics and dates when this convention is usually held.

There is an insurance agent that could talk about retirement insurance. They also have a band.

Will start looking for speakers after February 6th.

BOD discussed ending the convention on Saturday night after Banquet.

NOTE - Sunday morning was always a time for open discussion between the board and the members (board was not always as accessible to members as it is now. The board worked all day Wednesday and Thursday plus evenings and did NOT attend presidents meetings, CBM meetings or mingle with members on the evening prior to convention, as there was usually a class scheduled at that time). Only those who could stay attended the Sunday morning session (many members leave on early flights on Sunday morning). Around 2010 changes to extend board meetings to include Wednesday though Monday Noon were made in order to rehash the convention, discuss any points brought up by members and finish board business. Sunday afternoon board meetings were made more effective by the board attending the Sunday morning session and answering questions.

AEA Website - Working on getting an appointment to get started with fixes.

<u>YahooGroups</u> - YahooGroups can still be used for announcements to BOD and members but, it will eventually be shut down. Emails are no longer archived automatically. They are being transferreded to a computer file manually, whenever something is posted. AEA will be switching to Groups.Google.com for its email lists. We are currently using GoogleSuites for notifying CBMs of online requests. It should not be too difficult to open groups for BOD and members.

- * Members can be added 10 at a time without sending invitations (no need for members to reply)

<u>**RSS Feed for Press Releases**</u> – Board was asked about possibly using a United Press (UP) / Associated Press (AP) RSS Feed for submitting press releases. Cost is about \$75.00 per press release. Using this type of feed, our press releases would be available to major newspapers, television and radio stations. Terry stated that with only one press release per month, at most, this would not be an outrageous cost.

With, hopefully, good results coming from our human research trial, it was suggested to start submitting generic press releases to get good reviews of the emu industry out in front of the media and the public's eyes so that they will be more receptive when the research results are published. Board is looking into other options.

<u>Health Science Institute (HIS)</u> – Several past articles on emu oil are in their archives with doctors listed who recommend emu oil. Possible source of future convention speakers. AEA will subscribe this month.

Expenses for Convention Reimbursement - Mileage & shipping of necessary items. There was a discussion on mileage costs for hauling AEA items across country. AEA logo items will be added for sale to newsletter. We hope to trim down our items for sale, so there will be less to transport. We will keep things as they are for the next convention but, this must be revisited before the 2021 convention.

5.) Deadline for Chairman of the Nominating Committee to be notified of results - 25 days prior to the Meeting. August 17
