2021 Convention -

NO IN-PERSON 2021 CONVENTION.

- * Discussed making videos available to members on various subjects (Home Butchering; Hatching; Marketing, Temple Grandin's Animal Behavior Observations; Soapmaking; Egg Carving; etc.) in the Members Area of the website using members as speakers, since they are the experts in the emu industry. There are also older Raising Emu videos that could be made available through the Members Area for 1 or 2 weeks only (since we do not have permission to make them available permanently). We will try to focus on subjects for new members and those new to the industry.
- * Discuss possibility of ZOOM Membership Meeting with meeting taped for other members to view later. Board voted to upgrade to Pro ZOOM so that it could not only be used for monthly meetings but, also, be used for the annual membership meeting.

Needs further discussion. This probably should go to Convention Audio/Visual Committee.

<u>2022 Convention</u> – We could wait until the first of next year to make a decision but, sooner would be better. Board wants a convention in 2022. This probably should go to the convention Committee.

<u>Convention Survey</u> – Only 2 responses. The survey will be reformatted with fewer questions and sent again. Questions might be:

Where to hold the convention? Room prices? Topics to discuss?

"The EMU; An Evolving Agri-business Brochure" – This 4 page PDF has been updated and sent to ET&T. It will also be posted to the AEA website.

<u>Website Video</u> – It was suggested that links to 2 minute videos on YouTube, be posted on the AEA website. This is also what we discussed for the convention. We have the professional videos from Alphabet Zoup that we could link to. AEA will review these videos.

Mt. Emu Video –We need to see if there is any problem with what is said about emu oil in this 1 minute video and, if there are problems, what are the recommendations to make it good. Waiting on response from oil committee at this time.

<u>Radio Promo</u> – Looking into a radio ad to air during National Emu Week. A package of 10 – 60 second spots (with an extra 5 since we are a non-profit and 2 more if we prepay) final cost to be determined. This could be used for National Emu Week (N.E.W.) and as a membership drive.

2021 Certified Business Member (CBM) – Per a new application, BOD was asked if a CBM applicant does not sell oil or meat (only feathers, eggs, chicks or live birds) must they fill out the emu oil certificate of analysis and proof of product liability insurance paperwork. BOD agrees that unless they start to sell emu oil or emu meat at any time in the future (in which case they would need to notify the AEA and fill out the appropriate paperwork) that these items are unnecessary. The AEA does encourage farm liability insurance to protect the farmer in case of visitor accident

<u>Call For Nominations</u> – We need 3 nominations – *Region 1 & 2*; Region 3; and one At-Large Director * Nominations Committee could use one more person on their committee.

2021 ELECTION TIMELINE

- Call for nominations no later than 156 days prior to the Annual Member Meeting September 11). April
 Call for nominations is emailed to the email lists on or by April 1, and in the next newsletter BEFORE April 8, announcing that nominations are currently open.
- **2.) Nominations must be received** by AEA 60 days later. **May 31. Bios** are then written by those who have said they are willing to run.
- Deadline for mailing of ballots to the members shall be 75 days prior to the Annual Meeting.

<u>State & Local Zoning</u> – If members contact BOD about zoning problems, refer them to Kym, who can possibly give them advice on how to proceed.

For future zoning problems it would be useful to:

- * Use the term livestock, as they are listed as livestock in most states (no longer exotic);
- * Remind officials that the emu is "soft-footed" thus not an erosion problem like hoofed animals;
- * And, the emu's shorter digestive track does not allow the build-up of odor causing gases, such as methane and ammonia, thus pens do not have that heavy manure smell.
