a. Discuss possibility of ZOOM Membership Meeting with meeting taped for other members to view at a later time. Board voted to upgrade to Pro ZOOM so that it could not only be used for monthly chats but, also, be used for the annual membership meeting.

b. Committees will discuss making videos available to members on various subjects (Home Butchering; Hatching; Marketing, Temple Grandin's Animal Behavior Observations; Soapmaking; Egg Carving; etc.) in the Members Area of the website and using members as speakers, since they are the experts in the emu industry. There are also older Raising Emu videos that could be made available through the Members Area for 1 or 2 weeks only. They will try to focus on subjects for new members and those new to the industry.

<u>2022 Convention</u> – We could wait until the first of next year to make a convention decision (but, sooner would be better). Board wants a convention in 2022. Convention Committee will review survey responses and start meeting in June to discuss 2022 convention.
