LOCAL DECORATED EMU EGG CONTEST SET FOR MAY

(TOWN), (state) - (date submitted) - (Farm or business name) is sponsoring an emu egg decorating contest as a part of National Emu Week (N.E.W.), May , 20).

Decorated emu eggs will be judged (in four categories; painted, carved, jeweled (Faberge style) and a special category for children under 12 years old). First prize (in each category) will be a (\$25.00) emu store gift certificate. The contest entry fee is (\$15.00) and this includes a clean blown emu egg.

These large, dark green eggs with layers of green, turquoise and white, lend themselves to the creation of beautiful art work. The eggs can be painted and hung like Christmas ornaments, carved with colorful patterns being uncovered and lacework cut that can be made into interesting items including nightlights. They can be made into jewelry boxes, music boxes, kaleidoscopes, jeweled like the famous Faberge eggs or with beautiful scenes inside.

Decorated emu egg entries must be received no later than (April 20, 20). On (April 28) the eggs will be judged and placed on public display at (store, library, bank, etc.) until (May 6, 20).
