Craft Paper

Craft paper can be used to transform any flat surface into the perfect backdrop for photographing jewelry, accessories and other small items. It's easy to find, it's incredibly affordable and it's available in a seemingly endless selection of patterns, colors and textures.

Wood Floors or Table Tops

Wood floors or table tops can add a warm, rustic background to your photos. Make sure the surface is clean before taking pictures. If your floors or table surface have a glossy finish, make sure you turn off your camera flash to avoid glare.

Concrete
