N.E.W. Event Ideas

Here are some suggestions that have been used since the beginning of "Emu Awareness Week" along with a few others that I hope you can use.

- * A **Proclamation** by the governor, mayor, town chair, etc., officially acknowledging the first full week of May (Saturday thru following weekend) as National Emu Week.
 - * Send **Decorated Eggs** to White House and governors of heavy emu states, announcing National Emu Week.
- * Hold and during N.E.W. Announce Winners of FFA / FHA / Farm Bureau Youth Essay Competition. Topic might be the Impact of the Emu on American Agriculture.
 - * Local **Art Competitions** (Emu Egg Art, Craft, etc., Contests).
- * Emu Cook-off. (Chili cook off, Emu Egg recipes, Church or Community Lasagna Dinner, etc.) Could be co-sponsored by your local community center, tech school, restaurant, or church group.
 - * Tee-shirt give-a-ways on local radio stations.
 - * Farm Tours / Open House / Celebration / Festival / etc. on your farm or ranch.
 - * Emu Burger, Bar-B-Q, Chili Feed, Food Stand "SPECIALS", etc.
 - * Emu Meat Raffle
- * Give **Samples** of emu meat, oil products and/or egg shell pieces. Make them available at malls, school activities, libraries, sporting events, church bazaars, dances, craft fairs, etc.
 - * Displays at libraries, schools, community center, malls, store front windows, display shelves, etc.
- * Informational Presentations at various meetings, i.e., schools, FFA, 4-H, Scouts, Rotary Clubs, Chamber of Commerce, Jaycees, Red Hat Ladies, Home Owner Association, Elks Club, etc.
- * **Restaurant participation** by arranging for a special emu sandwich, emu entree, emu meat pizza, etc. during National Emu Week.
 - * Set an incubator at your local school's science class and hatch several eggs.
 - * Take a chick to local schools, nursing homes, senior centers, etc.
- * Video tape a "tour" of your farm and show this video at local schools, nursing homes, senior centers or clubs. Bring an egg shell and shell pieces, emu leather, feathers, etc. Things they can "feel".
 - * Donations of:
- **Emu Oil donated** to local sports teams, nursing homes, burn units, chiropractors, massage therapists, fire departments, etc.
 - **Emu Meat donated** to soup kitchens, YWCA/YMCA's, Salvation Army, etc.

Don't forget to submit a press release or contact you local newspaper about these donations.

- * **Sponsor a sports team** with money for uniforms, equipment, etc., e.i., little league, soft ball, bowling teams, etc. (turn them into walking billboards with your business visibly displayed)
- * **Demonstrations by experienced chefs** on preparing emu meat. Demonstrations could be done at homemaker meetings, organizational meetings, stores, malls, shows, fairs or craft events.
 - * Join with local businesses to Host a Community Emu Festival in your area.
- * Large (full, 1/2 or 1/4 page) **Ad in your "big city" or state newspapers**. Several farms, a district, a co-op or a state emu association could do this as a group project to lower costs. This could be an individual or group project. Even a classified ad announcing N.E.W. with contact information will generate interest.
 - * Set-up Information at Interstate Visitor Centers.
